### Kuranda Seyit (Australia)

Brother Kuranda is a founder and the Executive Director of Forum on Australia's Islamic Relations (FAIR). With a Bachelor in Education, he was for many years a teacher, and having conducted various youth camps, is a wealth of experience. An authority on the media, Brother Kuranda is a prominent voice for the Muslims in Australia. With his extensive knowledge in Islamic history and theology, and of the Australian community, he is regularly invited to speak at forums and conferences. He was selected amongst 100 leading Australians in the field of society, awarded Pride of Australia Medal for peace and was a runner up to Citizen of the Year Auburn Australia Brother Kuranda has produced and directed a number of educational documentaries and is also a freelance writer. He is 34, married, with a young child.

### Waleed Arafa (Egypt/USA)

Born in Michigan USA Brother Waleed has been based in Cairo many years now. A co host of EHNA, a television show in Egypt, he addresses issues of importance to youth.
