GUEST SPEAKERS

SHAYKH SUHAIB WEBB

Shaykh Suhaib Webb is a contemporary American Muslim activist and speaker. He accepted Islam at the age of twenty, three years after he received a copy of the Al-Quran. After converting to Islam, he left his career as a DJ and studied at the University of Central Oklahoma, where he graduated with a Bachelors degree in Education. He also studied privately under a Senegalese Shaykh, learning enough Islam and Arabic to become a community leader in Oklahoma City, where he was hired as Imam at the Islamic Society of Oklahoma City. In 2004, he departed with his Malaysian wife and two children to Cairo, where he currently studies at Al-Azhar University in the College of Shari'ah, Additionally, he works with the Grand Mufti of Egypt. Sheikh Ali Goma'a, where he is in charge of the English translation Department at Dar al-Ifta al-Masriyah and is currently training as a Mufti.

DR. AHMAD FAROUK MUSA

Dr Farouk is an academician at Monash University. He was trained as a cardiothoracic surgeon and an ardent researcher who has presented his works across Asia and Europe. He had delivered talks related to Islam in universities and other Islamic centres in Malaysia. He is currently the Chairman of Islamic Renaissance Front (IRF), the newly launched intellectual movement and a think tank focusing on youth empowerment and promotion of intellectual discourse and reformation.

WAN NORHAZIKI WAN ABDUL HALIM

Wan Norhaziki is currently a Senior Executive at the Bank Negara Malaysia, specializes in Banking and Financial Law, Islamic Banking and Finance, Islamic Legal Theory, Islamic Commercial Jurisprudence and Political Science. He holds a Master of Law (LL.M) in Banking Law, as well as Master in Islamic Legal Theory from the IIU Malaysia.
